## **TREE DONATIONS**

Forest Hill Cemetery has put together a tree donation and fund to support the needs of the cemetery for many years.

If you would like to purchase a tree garden you may do so. The following guidelines have been put in place to help you with this memorial decision.

- 1. You will need to make an appointment with the cemetery Horticultural Director to determine which tree you would like to purchase.
- 2. The Horticultural Director will show you places within the cemetery for you to have the tree planted.
- 3. Forest Hill Cemetery will pick up the tree, plant the tree and maintain the tree.
- 4. The cost involved are broken down into the following categories:
  - The cost of the tree will be determined after it has been picked out by the buyer. The cemetery maintains a list of trees and cost to pick from.
  - There will be a \$25.00 planting fee
  - There is a \$50.00 maintenance fee this is for five years and involves pruning and seeing that the tree is watered during its first year.
  - A charge of \$30.00 will apply for the placement of a memorial sign. These signs will have the following message on them:

## TYPE OF TREE IN MEMORY OF \_\_\_\_\_ DATE PLANTED

So it may look like this:

Winterking Hawthorn Crataegus viridis 'WinterKing' In Memory of John Doe July 2009
